The history behind this range is as fascinating as it looks...

In the year 2002 Roger and his wife made a roundtrip of the United States which included the opening of an art exhibition in an Indian settlement south of San Francisco in the village San Bautista.

Roger was invited by the Chief, Sonne Reyna, who is also a Shaman, which means he is in close contact with the powers of nature and performs traditional acts of healing and blessings.

During a ceremony for the occasion, which also included a vision into the future, Chief Sonne saw, in a vision, that Roger will paint pictures of the sun.

This "Sun" would be known around the world and "created many times"

Roger's immediate comment was "but I don't paint suns, sunrises or sun settings...". It was with a certain scepticism in spite of the fact that many of the visions and acts of healing seemed real and immediate.

But now it is here...!!!

It was not sun on canvas – the vision has manifested itself in the form of a range of sculptural furniture.

The idea for the sculptural furniture is centred around the ladyfingers used in the Italian dessert Tiramisu, also known as savoiardi, arranged as the circle of the sun.
